Which mattress pad should I choose?

3 questions to consider

Is moisture resistance needed?

Yes –  – No

Wool

Cotton

Wool's natural wicking action plus the pad's close, tight weave mean moisture will bead up on the pad's surface rather than soaking straight through.

The wool pad is the best choice for cribs, co-sleeping, or accident-prone situations. The quilted organic cotton pad is a comfortable, reliable choice for ordinary use, when moisture resistance isn't critical.

Am I able/willing to hand-wash?

Never –  – Sometimes

Wool

The cotton pad is machine washable in cold water and can be tumble dried ("air" or no-heat setting), though line drying is best.

Wool does shrink when agitated by machine, so hand washing and line drying will best preserve its shape. Some people machine-wash the wool pad in cold water on the delicate cycle; some shrinkage must be expected in that case. Line drying is recommended.

Do I "sleep hot"?

Yes –  – No

Wool

Cotton

Strands of wool are covered with microscopic "hooks" that create thousands of tiny air pockets. These create wool's excellent insulating capacity, which helps the body better regulate temperature.

Wool helps to dissipate excess heat beneath the body, so the wool pad increases comfort for sleepers who experience heat surges or heavy perspiration during sleep.
